

## **Extra Point, Slotted, Slanted, Pointed Swiss, and Point/Slant Combination Tweezers**

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Hair removal makes up a large part of a salon's business. In some cases, 50% or more of the services performed are hair removal. Sanitation is a very important part of hair-removal procedures, as well as what tools are use for each procedure and what is involved.

Tweezing is used to touch up after waxing. Also, if clients are sensitive to waxing, tweezing is a slower, but effective alternative for dark, coarse hair on the brow, lip, and chin area.

### **Usage**

- ❑ To remove hair with tweezers, first hold the skin taunt around the area where you are removing the hair.
- ❑ Place the tweezer at the base of the hair, and gently but firmly pull at a slight angle, matching the direction of the hair growth
- ❑ Some therapists use a magnifying lamp during a tweezing procedure.
