Preparation:

1. Set aside 4-5 dry, clean cotton towels.
2. Fill a basin with hot water to use in dampening hot towels for cleansing and compresses.
3. Mix 1 teaspoon of **Sweet Milk Lavender Bud Exfoliate** and 1 teaspoon of **Finer Herbal Cleanser** in a rubber mixing bowl.
4. Mix 1/8th teaspoon of the **Rose Hip and Clay Mint Mask** with 1 oz. of spring water in a rubber mixing bowl.
5. Place a dry towel on the head area of your facial chair or treatment table to catch any herbs that may fall during the exfoliation.

Procedure:

1. Remove any eye makeup with **Eyebright Treatment Oil**, by placing a small amount on moistened cotton pads. (Do not use on dry cotton.) Reapply **Eyebright Treatment Oil** to moist cotton rounds and rest on closed eyelids
2. Turn on the steamer and position toward face to soften skin and open pores
3. Moisten the face with warm, wet towel compresses.
4. Using your wet hands or sponges, apply a small amount of **Fine Herbal Cleanser** to the face using circular motion to cleanse the skin. Remove with a warm damp cloth or wet sponges. Repeat the cleansing application, ending by removing Cleanser with long light stroking motion upwards toward temples.
5. Remove the steamer from the face.
6. Analyze the Skin. Perform extractions if needed.
7. Apply **Pure Complexion Tonic** using cotton pads or fingertips. Pay close attention to edge of mouth, the nose, and between the brows, where extra oil can collect.
8. Dampen the skin with sponges. Exfoliate the face using the **Sweet Milk and Lavender Bud Facial Exfoliate** and **Fine Herbal Cleanser** mixture by applying it to face with your fingertips. This exfoliating massage will increase circulation while the natural alpha hydroxy action of the lactic acid is activated in the dried milk to smooth skin in tone and texture.
9. Thoroughly wipe away excess exfoliate with warm damp sponges using an upwards motion.
10. *OPTIONAL: Apply Deep Lavender Rub* (not included in Success Kit) to upper chest area. Cover with a warm towel and press into chest to penetrate and open any chest congestion (great for circulation and relaxation) while applying Mask
11. *OPTIONAL: If skin is normal to dry or mature*, you may apply **Nourishing Herbal Cream** (not included in the Success Kit) as a mask to feed the skin and moisturize the face and neck. Dampen face with sponges then apply Cream with fingertips. Remove the Mask with warm towel. Press into skin to allow heat to penetrate and hydrate while removing any unabsorbed product. Finish Mask removal by sponging.
12. *If skin is normal, oilier, congested or in need of deeper cleanse*, apply **Rosehip and Clay Mint Mask**. Allow to dry 3-4 minutes or until edges begin to turn white, then remove with wet sponges. Perfect for decongesting clogged pores

13. Décolleté: If **Deep Lavender Rub** has been applied to chest, remove towel and lightly massage the rub into the décolleté. If the Deep Lavender Rub has not been used, massage **Nourishing Herbal Cream** (not included in the Success Kit) into the chest area or apply **Nourishing Lavender Milk** to provide additional hydration.
14. Remove the **Rosehip and Clay Mint Mask** with a warm, moist towel. Press into skin to allow wet heat to penetrate and hydrate, while removing any unabsorbed product. Finish mask removal by sponging.
15. Moisture Massage: Apply **Nourishing Lavender Milk** under the eyes and on the neck or other areas still in need of moisture. Lightly work into the skin.
16. Using a damp towel, remove any excess product. Press the towel into skin. Remove and tilt head side to side to make sure all product has been removed and the complexion is clean and moist. Ensure this by “finger-tipping” the client, including behind ears and behind neck. (flick away any bits of herb with dry towel).
17. *OPTIONAL*: Finish facial with a reviving spritz of **Cool Aloe Mist** (not included in Success Kit) .The aloe settles the complexion, while lavender and bergamot are antiseptic as well as wonderfully fragrant ... a perfect ending to a uniquely pure and purposeful facial

Tips for Enhancing the Effectiveness of the Treatment

- Communication is the key to enhancing the effectiveness of your skin care treatments. - Using sterile needles is a must when extracting comedones and using a needle holder will make your job easier. Both are available from Universal Companies.
- Product is easy to remove with warm moist towels. In order to always have a ready supply of towels, you may want to invest in a Hot Towel Cabi. Universal Companies has several models available.
- Analyzing the skin and performing extractions will be easier if you have a good magnifying lamp with a built in light source. Universal Companies has several models available including a Headband Magnifier.
- The Wood's Lamp is a vital tool to help estheticians diagnose underlying skin conditions. Universal Companies has several models available – a Handheld Wood's Lamp, a Wood's Lamp With Stand, and a Skin Inspection Unit.

Creating Interest in the Treatment
