Intensive Service Aftercare Instructions

- 1. Do not touch or rub your eyes, eyelashes, or eyebrows immediately after the Intensive tinting service.
- 2. If redness or irritation occurs, apply a cool damp cotton compress to your eye area.
- 3. If symptoms persist for more than 24 hours, seek medical advice.
- 4. The effects of the Intensive service will start to diminish within 2 to 3 weeks as hair grows out and the color fades. Strong sunlight/UV light can make the Intensive color fade faster.

- 5. Avoid washing your hair, eyelids, eyelashes, eyebrows, or swimming for 24 hours, as these activities can cause the Intensive service results to fade.
- 6. Avoid exfoliating facial cleansers as those containing AHAs or other chemical exfoliates may decrease the life of the Intensive service application. A gentle facial cleanser or eye makeup remover is recommended 24 hours after the Intensive tinting service.
- 7. Do not apply makeup or mascara to lashes or receive any other eye services for at least 24 hours after the Intensive Lash or Brow tinting application.
- 8. Use oil-free makeup remover and facial products around the eye area to prolong the Intensive color.
- 9. For best results, rebook your Intensive Lash and/or Brow service every 3 to 4 weeks.
