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



IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Improper use of this device can cause injury. Be sure to read all operating instructions prior to use to prevent injury to operator or client.

*Electrical Shock Hazard.* To reduce the risk of electric shock, always disconnect the table from the electrical outlet before moving the table or doing any maintenance or troubleshooting procedures. Never use this equipment if it has a damaged cord or plug. Use this equipment only for its intended use as described in these instructions. Do not use any attachment or accessories not recommended by the manufacturer.

To reduce the risk of burns, fire, electrical shock or injury:

- The power supply/control module is located under the top. Refer servicing to qualified personnel and follow manual instructions when doing any authorized troubleshooting. Before doing any work on the unit, disconnect the power cord from the power outlet.
- Before cleaning with any liquid cleaner be sure to un-plug the power cord from the power outlet. Do not operate the table in standing water.
- Before moving the table, disconnect the power cord from the power outlet and secure the electrical cord, out of the way for moving.



### IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS (CONT.)

#### **GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS:**

This product must be grounded. If it should malfunction or breakdown, grounding provides a path of least resistance for electrical current to reduce the risk of electric shock. This product is equipped with a cord having an equipment-grounding conductor and a grounding plug. The plug must be plugged into an appropriate outlet that is properly installed and grounded in accordance with all local codes and ordinances (see example below of a norminal 120-volt circuit). Make sure that the product is connected toan outlet having the same configuration as the plug.

No adapter should be used with this product.



**DANGER-**Improper connection of the equipment-grounding conductor can result in a risk of electric shock. 

Electronically adjustable top, controlled by a multifunctional hand control, allows you to effortlessly change your position while relaxing on the lounge.

The *Relaxation Lounge*<sup> $\mathbb{M}$ </sup> should not be used in any other manner than that described within this manual. Use of any unnecessary force or unauthorized procedures could result in injury to practitioner, client or equipment.

The variety of reclining positions align the *Relaxation Launge*<sup>TM</sup> top so your body is at the optimum level for comfort. It features a single hand control to make the precise adjustments to the back and knee rest positions allowing a custom fit to each client.


When operating the *Relaxation Lounge*<sup>™</sup> controls be sure to observe all cautions and warnings given in the manual to prevent injury to both operator and client.

### CAUTIONS

Do not sit on the elevated Back Rest or Leg Rest.

Children must be supervised when around this equipment by a responsible adult. Do not leave children alone or allow them to operate the controls. Do not allow children to crawl into the cabinet or under the table.





Press and hold the appropriate button until the position desired is achieved and then release.

### INSTALLATION

#### • Leveling Feet

When operating the *Relaxation Lounge*<sup>™</sup> controls be sure to observe all cautions and warnings given in the manual to prevent injury to both operator and client. The *Relaxation Lounge*<sup>TM</sup> comes completely assembled and ready to use. Plug the cord into a functioning outlet that is rated for the table.

Arrange the power cord and control cords so that they will not create a tripping hazard. Place the controls in a safe location where they are convenient and accessible. Keep the controls out of the way of all table mechanisms.

#### **EVELING INSTRUCTIONS:**

#### If Lounge Will Not Sit Flat on the Floor:


The *Relaxation Lounge*<sup>TM</sup> is equipped with Leveler Feet that adjust to level the table on uneven floors. To adjust the Leveler Feet to suit common floor differences you will need to use a 1/2° open-end wrench or an adjustable wrench. Adjust each leg individually in turn by adjusting the height of each leveler foot until the unit rests level and steady. This adjustment will not effect the function of the table.





The lounge weighs 250 lbs. DO NOT lift or move the unit without using proper safety procedures or equipment. DO NOT turn the Relaxation *Lounge*<sup>™</sup>on its side for any reason. To do so could cause damage to the base and will void the warranty. There are no serviceable items that require this action. Never lift the lounge by grasping the lounge top as the table top is not designed to hold the weight of the base and you could damage the table.



Before moving the *Relaxation Lounge*<sup>\*\*</sup>, disconnect the power cord from the power outlet and secure the electrical cord, hand control and foot controls for moving.

#### MOVING THE Relaxation Lounge":



The *Relaxation Lounge*<sup> $\mathbb{T}$ </sup> weighs approximately 250 lbs. You will need 4 people working together if it is necessary to move the table. Never lift the table by grasping the table top as the table top is not designed to hold the weight of the base and you could damage the table and the electronics that run the tabletop.

If you need to move the table, place one person at each corner of the table. We recommend that you have the table top in a flex position to have the table top ends out of the way as much as possible. Have each person firmly grasp the cabinet base at the bottom by the table legs and lift the table from the base. As when moving any piece of heavy equipment, bend at the knee and lift with your legs beneath you and not with your back. Be aware and use proper, safe procedures for moving a table of this size to prevent injury to yourself or the table. We strongly recommend that a flatbed dolly be used that can hold the entire table if moving the table involves any distance.


#### MPORTANT



DO NOT store or place anything on the hood under the backrest as this can cause damage to the top and/or hood.

#### IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTE • *Relaxation Lounge*<sup>™</sup>

The hood area under the backrest top is not designed for storage or as an area to hold accessories while with a client. DO NOT use this area for holding *anything*. Damage can occur to the table, especially when commands that are accessed by the hand control are activated. Placing anything on this area will prohibit movement of the backrest and can cause damage to the table or the object and will void the warranty.




#### INSTALLING THE SIDE CONSOLE

Materials Needed: 1 shelf assembly 1 hanger assembly 1 lock chip


- 1. Remove the pads from the Relaxation Lounge.
- 2. Install the hanger assembly as shown, straddling the seat board on either side of the lounge.



3. Push hanger all the way down as shown.



4. Insert shelf between the seat board and the hanger assembly as shown. Align notched edge with hanger assembly. Push all the way back against the lounge.




•Installing the side console for the Relaxation Lounge


### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

5. Push the shelf to the left to lock on the hanger assembly.



6. Insert Lock Chip in the gap on the left side as shown.




7. Feed the wires under the relaxation lounge and clip them into the provided wire clips.

8. Remove the backrest dust cover and lift out the wire grommet cap. Place the side console power cord through the grommet system and plug the power cord into the provided power strip inside the table.



9. Replace the grommet cap, dust cover and Relaxation Lounge pads.







#### INSTALLING THE OPTIONAL READING LIGHT


1. Remove the black cap from the shelf. Insert the pin provided in the light kit so that it is flush with the under side of the shelf.



2. Insert the screw in the pre-drilled hole on the under-side of the shelf.



3. Remove the reading light room the box and place into the pin in the shelf as shown below.



4. Plug the power cord into the outlet.

#### OPTIONAL SOUND SYSTEM



A personal sound system is available for the *Relaxation Lounge*<sup>TM</sup>. The system consists of a 3 speaker system with 2 speakers located a the head end of the lounge, and one speaker located inside the lounge or under the optional console. The speakers on the head end of the lounge can be moved out of the way when not in use. The system can play music from MP3 or any source with a headphone output. The volume control and on/off switch is conveniently located next to the table control buttons.

The MP3 input can be plugged into the volume control or direct into the base speaker unit (Sometimes located inside the frame) Access is obtained by removing the headrest dust cover.





Note: To remove dust cover, slide forward 1/2 inch, then lift.

Caution - When the speakers are folded in the down position make sure they are clear of the frame before operating any controls! (Speakers in contact with the frame can be severly damaged!)

### MPORTANT

#### If the *Relaxation Lounge*<sup>TM</sup> will not change position:

- Check the outlet to be sure that it has power and that the power cable is plugged in. Try the Hand Control to see if it works.
- Unplug the power cable from the wall outlet. Remove dust cover. Make sure that all male and female connectors are firmly pushed into the control box. Even a slight misconnection can cause a possible malfunction. Plug the unit back into the wall and check the controls again. If one or more of the controls still do not work, contact Customer Service at 800-558-8850 to arrange replacement.



Before doing any work on the unit, disconnect the power cord from the power outlet.

### CARE & CLEANING

#### IMPORTANT



Before cleaning with any liquid cleaner be sure to un-plug the power cord from the power outlet. Do not operate the table in standing water.

#### HOW TO CARE FOR YOUR UPHOLSTERY:

In order to maintain the quality and ensure the life of the *Relaxation*  $\textit{Lounge}^{\text{m}}$ , here are some preventative steps that can be taken to protect the upholstery on the chair and accessories.

- Clean your upholstery faberic every day. We recommend cleaning your upholstery fabric with a mild detergent to protect it against oil stains and dirt which will cause cracking and permanent stains over time. Household products you can use include a 4:1 diluted solution of 409® cleaner, Fantastik® or any non-abrasive with a non-alcohol content. Products with a high alcohol content, when used over time, will dry and eventually crack your upholstery fabric. Note: Damage caused by these cleansers will not be covered under the warranty.
- Avoid extremes in temperature. Very cold temperatures can make your fabric prone to cracking. Very high temperatures can cause the fabric to stretch permanently.
- Avoid exposing your products to direct sunlight for extended periods of time. This can lead to fading and cracking of the fabric.

Cushions may be replaced for a charge, but you can lengthen the life of the upholstery fabric on your lounge by following these quick and easy suggestions.

• Base & Controls

#### GENERAL CARE OF EQUIPMENT COMPONENTS:

- Use only a mild solution of 4:1 diluted non-alcohol cleaner such as 409°, Fantastik° or some other non-abrasive cleaner to wipe down the metal and wooden surfaces. Apply with a damp (not wet) lint-free cloth. Be sure excess liquid does not drip onto, or into, any of the electrical controls or mechanisms. Be sure that the unit is unplugged before cleaning these areas. Wipe these areas carefully with a lint free cloth.
- The electronic powering mechanism of your *Relaxation Lounge*<sup>™</sup> requires no general maintenance or lubrication.
- The wooden cabinetry of the equipment can be polished with any polish approved for wooden surfaces. Spray, or pour, the polish onto a soft cloth and be careful not to get it onto other surfaces.
