


WARNING A




- ✓ DO NOT pour any liquid directly into the warmer.
- ✓ DO NOT place additional pressure or weight on a wall mounted unit. The unit may fall.
- ✓ DO NOT use unit near explosive gases. Fires may occur.
- ✓ Remove ALL packaging before using.
- ✓ Plug into a Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter (GFCI), a receptacle to protect you if water and electricity mix. Properly ground the Bottle Warmer. Failure may increase the risk of electric shock.

DESCRIPTION

Your Bottle Warmer is a simple and trouble-free unit to operate. The housing, cylinders and bottom are all made from type 304 stainless steel. The control is an ON/OFF switch on the front of the unit. The internal thermostat/temperature sensor is non-adjustable and preset to a normal operating temperature. The unit has removable plastic bottles for therapeutic lotions and gels.

SETTING UP

1. Your new Bottle Warmer includes the following:

- ✓ (1) Bottle Warmer Model -EBW1, -EBW2, -EBW3, or -EBW4
- √ (1,2,3 or 4) 8 ounce plastic dispenser bottle(s)
- √ (1) Wall mounting hardware package
- √ (1) Warranty Registration Card
- ✓ (1) Operating Instructions Booklet with Wall Mounting Template

If you are missing anything, please call the phone number listed on the inside front cover.

2. Unpacking your Bottle Warmer

Remove all shipping material. Remove the dispensing bottles. Clean the unit and dispensing bottles thoroughly before using.

3. Device Placement

Place the Bottle Warmer at a convenient level, such as on a table or a scratch-resistant counter-top. Before moving the Bottle Warmer, unplug and cool the unit. The unit may also be wall mounted, using the template supplied. Follow the instructions printed on the template.

CHECKING OUT my Bottle Warmer

Before the FIRST use, check the following:


- 1 The Bottle Warmer should be level.
- 2 The Bottle Warmer should be plugged directly into a properly grounded GFCI receptacle. Do not use an extension cord. Under sized extension cords can overheat.
- 3 The Bottle Warmer should be in good condition.
- 4 The dispensing bottles should be filled to within 1/2" of the top.




USING the Bottle Warmer


Remove the dispensing bottle from the Bottle Warmer.




Apply the gel or lotion in the prescribed method.



Return the dispensing bottle to the Bottle Warmer for reheating.



For multiple bottle units, use dispensing bottles starting on left and working towards right. Refill emptied bottles following instructions on page 7.





CAUTION A



- DO NOT apply the gels or lotions over cuts, lacerations or abrasions.
- DO NOT use additives, disinfectants or other chemicals in the dispensing bottles.
- Use extra care and judgement when using the Bottle Warmer with infants and the elderly.
- Use extra care and judgement when using the gels or lotions on thin skin or "bony" areas.
- During treatment, check the condition of the patient and the treated area often.



CLEANING

1-You will need:

- Sponge, cloth or non-abrasive cleaning pad.
- Stainless steel cleaner, such as Sheila Shine[®] or 3M Stainless Steel Cleaner & Polish.**
- Synthetic abrasive cleaning pad, such as Scotch-Brite®.**
- Soap, ammonia, detergent or mild disinfectant.
- Household wax (Color-coated units only).
- Mild acid such as white vinegar.**

**Use ONLY on stainless steel surfaces.




A CAUTION




- DO NOT use steel wool it will rust and embed in the stainless steel surface.
- DO NOT use bleach, chlorinated solvents or other chemicals they will leave a residue on your unit and will shorten the life of the dispensing bottles.


2-Routine Cleaning (every 2 weeks or as needed).

Facing the front of the unit, find the red power switch in the lower, center of the unit. Turn the power to the OFF position. The light will go out.





Let the gel cool to room temperature. Remove the dispensing bottle(s).




Wash inside and outside with a sponge, cloth or cleaning pad using a mild soap solution. For "hard water" spots and scale, scrub the area using a strong solution of vinegar and water. Let stand for 5 minutes.






3-Special Cleaning (Color coated surfaces).

Follow steps 1 - 4 on page 8 (Do not use vinegar on color coated surfaces). Wash the outside with a sponge or cloth using a mild soap solution. Do not use abrasive compounds, cleanser or pads. Verify the resistance to chemicals and solvents before using.





Dry with a soft cloth to avoid water marks.





To maintain and restore gloss, use a household wax.











4-Special Cleaning(stains, spots and scratches-stainless steel surfaces only).

Follow steps 1-4 on page 8. Apply the stainless steel cleaner to a damp cloth, sponge, or synthetic cleaning pad. Follow manufacturer's instructions for using cleaner.





Warmer Mounting Template Bottle



instructions for Use The tools you will need:

* Hammer * Phillips Screwdriver

* Level

* Scotch Tope * Ruler

1-Remove this template from the Operating instructions booklet.

2—Tope this template to the wall with the Scotch Tope. Make sure the anchors clear the wall studs and the top edge of the template is level.

3—Align the Bottle Warmer with the top edge of the template and the dashed outlines to show the finished location. Remove the Bottle Warmer. Repeat Step 2, if necessary.

4—Using the hammer, pound the anchors straight into the wall, through the templote. Make sure the anchors match these center to center dimensions:

4—Using the phillips screwdriver, turn the #8 screw clockwise into the onchor until it stops. Turn the screw 1 full turn counter-clockwise.

8-3/8 Horizontal 11-7/8 Horizontal

5—Tear this template off the wall. Align the slotted holes in the back of the Bottle Warmer with the screws in the wall. Slide the Bottle Marmer down onto the screw until it stops. Your Bottle Marmer is now ready for use.

MAINTENANCE

The Bottle Warmer design is nearly maintenance-free. It should, under most conditions, give many vears of reliable service.

1-Routine Maintenance (as needed)

Follow steps 1-6 on pages 8 and 9 for Routine Cleaning.

Always keep the dispensing bottles full. Refill the bottles as needed.

2-Monthly Maintenance

Follow steps 1-4 on page 10 for cleaning stains, spots and scratches.

3-Yearly Maintenance

• Have a professional electrician thoroughly check the following:

1. Test for leakage current, dielectric strength, receptacle polarity and ground. If you need test details, call the phone number listed on the inside front cover.

2. Check the power cord and plug. They should be free of cuts, abrasion and other damage. Replace the power cord assembly if it is damaged. Use only factory authorized replace-

ment parts.

3.Remove the cover and check all electrical components and connections. Replace any parts that are in questionable condition. Use only factory authorized replacement parts.

STORAGE

1-Storing the Bottle Warmer

Follow steps 1-6 on pages 8 and 9 for Routine Cleaning.

Place the Bottle Warmer upright in a dry area away from any chemicals.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Cause	Solution
Gel doesn't get warm, even though unit is plugged in and switch is ON.	-Circuit breaker is off.	-Turn on the circuit breaker.
	-Thermostat is not working.	-Replace the thermostat
	-Thermal fuse has been burned out.	-Replace the thermal fuse.
	-The ON/OFF switch is broken	-Replace the switch
	-Contact with ferrous metal.	-Remove the ferrous metal item from the unit-usually a staple, paper clip, safety pin, etc. Clean thoroughly.



TECHNICAL INFORMATION

Electrical Information

The Electric Bottle Warmer, Models -EBW1, -EBW2, -EBW3, -EBW4 requires 120 Volts AC and 60 Hz. The -EBW1 will draw .25 amps; the -EBW2 draws .5 amps; the -EBW3 draws .75 amps; the -EBW4 draws 1 amp. The 8' power cord ends with a "Hospital Grade" plug, an Underwriters' Laboratories Inc. verification for abuse resistant wiring devices. The other electrical components include double pole, single throw (DPST) lighted ON/OFF switch, a one-shot thermal fuse, a snap action thermostat and fiberglass insulated rope heaters.
