Classification	Flammable Liquids — Category 3

4. First-aid measures

Inhalation	Move to fresh air. Obtain medical advice if symptoms persist.

5. Fire-fighting measures

Suitable extinguishing media	Alcohol-resistant foam, dry chemical, carbon dioxide or water fog.
Specific hazards	Flammable liquid and vapour. Vapours may ignite. Heated containers may rupture.
Protective equipment	Firefighters should wear appropriate protective equipment and self-contained breathing apparatus where required.

6. Accidental release measures

Personal precautions	Remove ignition sources. Ventilate area. Avoid breathing concentrated vapour or mist.
Environmental precautions	Avoid uncontrolled release to drains and surface water.
Cleanup	Absorb with inert non-combustible material and place in a suitable labelled container.

7. Handling and storage

Handling	Keep away from heat, sparks, flames and hot surfaces. Use with adequate ventilation. Do not spray toward face.
Storage	Keep tightly closed in a cool, well-ventilated place away from ignition sources and strong oxidizers.
