Can be used with the galvanic unit, a steamer, or an electric mask. pH - 8.3.

Usage Instructions

With the Steamer:

- 1. Soak cotton compresses with the Disincrustation Lotion and apply to the areas of the skin where clogged pores are present.
- 2. Steam for 10 25 minutes depending on the severity of oiliness.
- 3. Use astringent to remove the oiliness emulsified by the Disincrustation Lotion from the surface of the skin.
- 4. Proceed with the extraction, squeezing blackheads, pimples and clogged pores.

With the Galvanic machine:

- 1. For disincrustation, use the negative current.
- 2. Apply Disincrustation Lotion to a gauze mask or to cotton compresses and pass the attachment slowly over the oily areas for about 4-6 minutes.
- 3. Proceed with the extractions as above.

With the electric mask:

- 1. Apply the Disincrustation Lotion to compresses of cotton or to a gauze mask, on the oily areas.
- 2. In the dry areas, apply a generous amount of penetration/hydrating cream or lotion.

- 3. Place a wet tissue soaked chamomile tea or water on top of the Disincrustation Lotion and the penetrating creams, making a small hole for the nose area.
- 4. Leave the heating mask on for 12 20 minutes.
- 5. Proceed with the extractions as above.

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
