



TCA Intense Peel

Tackle tired and aging skin immediately with this intense peel treatment. This peel uses 20% trichlorocetic acid (TCA)—which has been used in peels for over 20 years—to dry and peel the top layer of the skin over a period of several days to a full week. Perfect for those who improve skin clarity and stimulate natural collagen production.

What You'll Need:

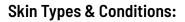

• Great for aging and acneic skin. Also works well for uneven skin tone and texture, various levels of hyperpigmentation, and Fitzpatrick I, II, and III.

Important Notes:

- Professional use only
- Use caution when administering TCA Intense Peel to Fitzpatricks 4-6
 - Due to the risk of of Post Inflammatory Hyperpigmentation, extensive skin preparation is mandatory, typically requring 6-8 months of pre-treatment
- This treatment shouldn't be performed on any client:
 - Who suffers from any skin condition or serious medical condition, such as immune disease, cancer, diabetes, eczema,

psoriasis, or herpes

- Who are allergic to asprin
- Who are pregnant or lactating
- Who have an active facial rash, cold sores, or lesions
- A patch test is recommended 24-48 hours prior to this peel procedure
- Sun protection should be used after this service
- Accutane: 1 year off
- Retin-A: Discontinue for 7-10 days prior to treatment
- Permanent Cosmetics: Wait 7 days then cover with occlusive barrier
- Immediately Post Lift or Facial Surgery: Needs doctor approval
- Rosacea: Will need to be evaluated
- Facial Waxing: Requires a 72-hour waiting period

What to Do:

- 1. **Cleanse and tone the skin thoroughly**, removing all makeup and debris. Perform a double cleanse, if necessary, and degrease with an AHA Toner. *We recommend Prosana Refining Mist*.
- 2. **Apply petroleum jelly** to the area under the lash line, around the nostrils, the vermilion border of the lips, and the corners of the mouth.
- 3. Saturate a 2x2 gauze pad with approximately 3-4 ml of TCA Intense Peel solution. Apply a single, even layer of TCA Intense to the skin, beginning at the forehead and working down the jaw line in short, even strokes. It's not necessary to layer this peel. "Frosting" will be visible, and a fan may be necessary for client comfort.
- 4. This peel is self-neutralizing when used alone. Once applied to the affected area, it cannot be neutralized.
- **5. To cool the skin**, apply a gentle cream cleanser (we recommend Prosana Cleansing Cream). Several rinses and applications of Cleansing Cream may be needed to help soothe the affected area. Gently massage any residual hot spots. Water alone may spike and trigger acids to further process.
- **6.** Apply a thin layer of your preferred calming balm or serum. We recommend the Prosana Calming Balm. If it's daylight, follow with a sun protectant product.
- 7. Instruct the client not to cleanse their face for 24 hours. Provide the client with a complete list of post-care instructions. Appropriate post-care is <u>mandatory</u> after receiving this peel.
- 8. For best results, reschedule the client for a **7-Day Post-Care Treatment**, such as a soothing facial with a gentle enzyme exfoliation. We recommend Prosana Lactic Enzyme Gel Peel (N9107).

Aftercare:

- 9. Recommend that clients do not wash their face for 24 hours after treatment.
- 10. **Avoid aggressive products** until an esthetician evaluates the skin at the 7-Day Post-Care Treatment.
- 11. Peeling can last up to 5-6 days post-treatment.
- 12. Schedule the client to return in 7 days for the gentle enzyme facial.
